Sovos ShipCompliant: Wine Preserve Assessment Update (April 14, 2026)

We have an update on our California Wine District Fee support, announced earlier this year.

As a reminder, certain California wine districts levy a fee on retail sales made by member wineries. Wineries that are members of one of these districts may elect to collect these fees from consumers at the time of purchase.

We will be live with these fee options on April 15.

We are launching support for five wine districts — one more than originally announced.

- Temecula: 1% fee on retail sales made in California.
- Amador: 1% fee only on sales made in the Amador wine region.
- Santa Barbara: 1% fee on retail sales made in California.
- Lodi: 1.5% fee on retail sales made in California.
- Livermore: 2% fee on retail sales made in California.

Once the fees are live, configure your fee selection on the Report Settings - Tax Preferences page. Find your California preferences and click the Onsite orders dropdown, then select the fee that applies to your district.

If you are not a member of one of these wine districts, no action is needed.
